Division 1 Meeting Minutes
November 21, 2010
Host: Whistle Stop Hobby Shop
Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio

The meeting was called to order at 2:00 PM by Assistant Superintendent Randy Dettmer. Twenty-six people were in attendance. Randy thanked the Hesses for hosting the meeting.

A moment of silence was held to remember Dave Athman who passed away.

A motion was made by Bill Hewitt to accept the minutes of the October meeting as published in the Peddler Freight. Bob Ashley, Sr. stated that the division order for the convention should be changed to specify Divisions 1, 4, and 5 instead of 4, 5, and 1 since we are all equal in our participation. The motion with the revision was seconded by Don Bonk and passed.

The Treasurer's Report was given by Bob Ashley, Jr. A motion was made by David Hazlett to accept the report pending audit. The motion was seconded by Don Bonk and passed.

●Bob Ashley, Jr. gave the following report on the Flea Market held November 7th:

- 92 people paid at the door
- 25 tables were rented; half were repeats from last year
- The division realized a net of \$420.95 (\$81.07 was from the concession stand)
- 59% of the attendees heard about the flea market from the Berea or Medina train shows,
- 14% heard about it by word of mouth,
- 14% heard about it at the Whistle Stop,
- 9% stopped by when they saw the signs when driving by,
- 4% read about it in the Peddler Freight.

●Larry Brown reported on membership:
Current membership is at 100 with 3 renewals
New railpass members signed-up at the flea market
The division realized \$112 from sales of donated items at the flea market; the proceeds will be used for gifts for new members.

●Next year's flea market discussion:
A motion was made by Elmer Johnson and seconded by Bob Ashley, Sr. to have a flea market on Sunday, 11/06/2011, at the same location. The motion passed. It was felt that putting fliers out at the Kirtland show was too early in the year and we should not do this

in 2011. David Hazlett suggested that we put out fliers again and also advertise in the Peddler Freight. Bob Ashley, Sr. made a motion to have fliers made up advertising the 2011 flea market and it was seconded by Don Bonk and passed. David Hazlett and Bob Ashley, Sr. will determine the number to be printed and where they will be put out.

●AP Certification Committee (Don Deakins, Chuck Boyer, and David Hazlett):

David Hazlett stated that he can now do the certification for the Golden Spike Award and that it be done by completing the different parts separately and not as one layout or module.

●Module update given by Bob Ashley, Sr.:
All eight division modules have been constructed and he is trimming them so the fascia can be put on. Anyone who can help just needs to call him and they can work on them anytime. You can work on the AP award by working on the modules. \$450 of the allotted \$600 has been used to date. We will need more money for turnouts, track, and wiring that is not donated. Also, a control system will need to be purchased.

●Jim Williams stated that Doug Nichols has decided to close Nick's Railway Supply at the end of the year. Larry Brown is hosting clinics every Wednesday evening at 7 PM at his layout in Ravenna and invited all who wanted to, to attend.

A motion was made by Don Bonk to adjourn the meeting. It was seconded by Bill Hewitt and passed. The meeting was adjourned at 2:42 pm.

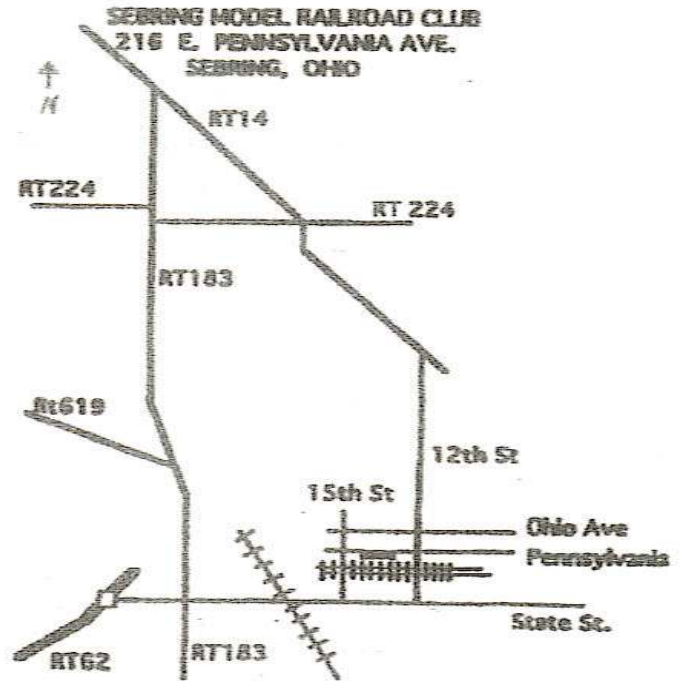

MODULE REPORT

Happy New Year everyone! I hope you have had a pleasant Holiday Season. OK, the fun is over, now, let us go back to work, on modules, I hope.

Bob Ashley, Jr. had a serious accident at his place of employment and was hospitalized, had surgeries to put his face back together and is now at home. He will be having more surgeries in the coming weeks. We are still planning, at this time, to have the modules ready for his March meeting. Because of the upcoming surgeries, this could change.

Five of the eight division modules are ready for sanding and paint. Difficulties and the Holidays have caused several module members to be unavailable to help. Anyone can help with the finishing of these modules. I will continue to finish the fascia panels and backdrop trimming of the modules. We hope to have the remaining three modules done by the time you read this. We have to order some of the wiring and electrical components. We have all the track, turnouts and roadbed to complete the main lines, thanks to a donation by Bill Smith. I expect we will need additional money or donations to complete the yards and electrical for the layout. Once we finish the painting, we will move the modules from my garage to Bob Ashley, Jr.'s garage, which is much larger. After that, we can start wiring and laying roadbed and track. Please tell me when you can come to work on the modules and I can adjust my schedule to fit yours, I think. Chuck Boyer has offered to help detail the modules. Way to go Chuck!!

I have had several requests for kits or finished standard modules. I will not be funding any more modules prior to construction. If anyone wants to pay in advance and is willing to come to my house to construct the module, then I will be willing to help build their module(s).

Those of you who have made the standard module, at my home, you owe me \$67.00 each for the materials and \$33.00 each for the wiring kit. This does not include the mandatory NCE UTP Facia Panel Socket for plugging in your throttle which is available for \$17.00 at The Whistle Stop. This works with Digitrax or NCE. Those of you, who have not paid me, please call me.

I need to know whether you are going to continue to be part of the module group or not. If you do not want to be in the module group, please return the modules to me or pay me for the cost of the materials mentioned. The money for the standard modules came out of my pocket. We are also looking for new module members. Please call me for information.

One person has not paid me for the two modules he helped build at the beginning of the program and took them with him. He has not taken the time to communicate with me as to why he has not paid me. If I do not hear from him by the meeting, I will bring this up at the meeting and mention his name to the membership. I have been ignored long enough.

I want to thank the division for investing in the module program. If we have the same success that Divisions 4 and 5 have had, this will provide a lot of entertainment for the members and the communities. It will also provide a way for each member to earn the AP awards.
