### SUPERINTENDENT'S MESSAGE

It is the height of the train show season. I love it when I find a great deal, don't you? Sometimes I get too greedy and buy several cars with the same numbers. If you are not operating, this isn't an issue but, if you operate, this can be. I had three Hooker Chemical Athearn 40 foot chemical tank cars with the same number: 56656. If you have one of these cars, you know that they are orange with black lettering. Now what to do? I didn't want to go and get new decals or scrape off a number. I wanted the cars to look like they are in the



same group. I searched and discovered that I had a black ultra fine point Sharpie pen. With the original number of 56656, I did a little scraping and redrew the last number on the first car. It seems that the number 6 can be easily modified into an 8; 8 into 3; 3 into 8; 9 into 8 and even 6 into 0. When I was done, I had three cars with three different numbers, the original 56656, 56650 and 56658. From a distance they look pretty good.

I had four Erie Lackawanna Athearn 50 foot gondolas with the same number, 15487. The problem with these is that the numbers are in white. I am not going to paint these with a OOO brush and white paint! At Jo-Ann Fabric I discovered they sell white paint fine point Sharpie pen. So I gave it a try. Interesting enough, it works! I was able to modify the numbers on three of the cars and ended up with cars with four different numbers: 15487, 15481, 15437 and 15497. I hope this gives you some ideas for your fleet.

Remaining Clinics will be:


April 27 - Glen Yoder at Rob's Trains, discussing "Fitting Buildings on Backdrop."





### N SCALE NEWS

Don Bonk

Last month, we tested a Bachmann EM-1 (2-8-8-4) N-Scale DCC model without sound belonging to Bruce Hukill on the Bonk Railroad. Performance was great. 50% power provided approximately 50 SMPH. At the prototype's normal working speed of 20 SMPH, operation was extremely smooth. Operation at 2 SMPH was good with very little jerking. Operating at 1 SMPH was possible, but jerking was noticeable. The forgoing operation was done with a train attached. While we did not get into rivet counting, the appearance was very good. A Bachmann EM-1 in N-scale can be found on the internet costing from about \$199 to \$350. Bachmann HO EM-1s with or without sound can be found for \$269.95 (Micro-Mark) to \$475.

About the same time last month, I found some old Peddler Freights, and the first Division 1 meeting at the Bonk RR was in May of 1978. My mentors, Howard Marsh and Floyd James, attended along with many of our other departed modelers, like Mary Lou Rice who won the 50/50 as she did most of the time.

We will begin the meeting at 2 PM.



### MODULE GROUP

- We will operate the Division HO and NTRAK modules at Dalton's Buckeye Event Center, March 23, 2014. We will setup on Saturday, March 22, 2014, between 5:00 PM and 9:00 PM.
- The National Train Show in Cleveland, in July, will have 92 straight modules. We are committing 8 straight modules and the industrial end modules. I will have 5 straight modules, Bob, Jr. will have 2 and Lloyd Horst will have 1. Larry Madson could not find a way to use the passenger end modules due to space considerations.
- I am concerned that several module members have lost interest or cannot make the events. We need more members to join in with more modules. I am adding two more modules to my coal mine and concrete/cement scenes. Those, of you, who have modules that you cannot use, please offer to sell them to someone who wants to join us. Jim Williams has three constructed and wired modules for sale. Dave Madden is considering making a yard with at least three modules for staging. He has not made his plans for this, yet.
- I have partially ordered the Digitrax electronics for a new command station panel from The Whistle Stop. They are having trouble finding a distributor who has stock. We will not have this ready for the next Dalton show. It will be mounted on the backside of the modules instead of underneath, where it is difficult to troubleshoot. We are using 2 American Flyer 250 watt, 16 amp, transformers for power, since; we can not find a suitable replacement for the (4) Magna Force, 5 amp, transformers at a decent price. We need more than 20 amps.
- Digitrax has provided a banner to display when we are operating with Digitrax. They also made a new Division banner, for us, at no charge.
- I have sent three throttles to Digitrax for conversion to the Duplex update and have received them in time to us them at the Dalton show. The Duplex will operate without interference with the cell phone repeaters and is not limited to one frequency, like the Digitrax Simplex and NCE or Lenz systems.
- To stop a runaway train with the throttle, press "Pwr" then "N" to kill the track power. The locomotive will run normally after restoring the track power. Digitrax recommends disabling the DC mode in the decoder to prevent a runaway.
- The "Module Group" logo is available through Jim Williams or Nils Sunberg for \$6.00 and can be added to your shirts. Please have this done before the upcoming displays. Thanks to all who have already done this.
- The Division portion of the 50-50 raffle is placed in the module fund. Let's try to be generous and spend \$5.00 for six tickets instead of \$1.00 for one ticket. We also receive \$100.00, or more, for our display at the Dalton shows. Your help in funding the Module Group is appreciated. We are buying a DCC system with this money to replace my personal DCC system.
