





#### **N-Scale News**

One of the best items available for N-Scale modelers at the March 2014 toy show in Dalton was the Warbird flat cars like the one shown on the right. One of "Burning River N-Trak" members assembles these with various paint jobs and details that run from the generic model I bought to a Tuskegee Airmen unit that takes 3-1/2 hours of additional effort. Costs are from \$34 to \$50.

There has been a discussion of obtaining a set of special run Division 1 Cars as a funding source. In N-Scale, Micro-Trains has already produced a box car perfect for the Akron Canton Youngstown Division with minor additions of a Division 1 Logo and "Division 1 N-Trak". 150 cars (3200 -3346) were built June 1948 and rebuilt in 1963 remaining in service until 1977.

## THERE IS A PROTOTYPE FOR EVERYTHING

Recently, I purchased a Bowser CP, ALCo C630M, #4507, locomotive. I took it to an operating session to do a little "Bring~N~Brag". We took it for a spin around the layout. As we were about to remove it from the layout, it was brought to my attention that the rear end sill or pilot under the frame and behind the hoses was missing. It really looked odd without the sill.

I called Bowser and talked to Lee about the missing part and lack of a parts list. He explained that this locomotive operated with out a rear sill on CP because it had been removed. The reason the parts list was missing was due to the many variations of the ALCo C630M. Making a parts list was deemed too expensive since each locomotive was so unique.

In my mind, I thought the locomotive would have looked better with the sill, but, in scale modeling, we are to try to make the models look like the prototype. So, I now feel happy that nothing is really missing and I got my "money's worth".

#### MODULE GROUP

The showing of the Division HO and NTRAK modules, last month, was a great success. The new Digitrax duplex system worked flawlessly without any interference from the cell phone repeaters in the building. My three converted throttles worked very well.

We displayed the new Digitrax banner and the new Division banner, both supplied to us at no charge, by Digitrax. The old banner has been passed on to the NTRAK group along with the frame. A new frame is being made for the HO module group, at no charge.

Our next showing will be at the National Train Show in Cleveland, in July. We will setup on Wednesday, July 16 and Thursday, July 17, 2014. The times will be announced, later. We will have approximately 92 straight modules plus the loop ends and corners. We are committing 8 straight modules and the industrial end modules. I will have 5 straight modules, Bob, Jr. will have 2 and Lloyd Horst will have 1. Larry Madson could not find a way to use the passenger end modules due to space considerations. We will operate Friday, July 18, Saturday, July 19 and Sunday, July 20 in shifts and will be expected to commit to a firm time schedule. There will be more about this and the times, later.

Anyone who works the NTS 2014 show must have shirts and hats with the "Division" and "Module Group" logo. They are available through Jim Williams or Nils Sunberg. Please have this done immediately. We want to look good. Thanks to all who have already done this.

Bob Ashley, Jr. is adding Tortoise turnout machines to the industrial end modules. Anyone with experience in installing these machines, and can help him, please call him at 330-645-6175 or 216-905-8860. He is making a control panel and hopes to have diode routing, eventually.

I am concerned that several module members have lost interest or cannot make the events. We need more members to join in with more modules. I have added two more modules to my coal mine and concrete/cement scenes. Those of you who have modules that you cannot use, please offer to sell them to someone who wants to join us. Dave Madden is considering making a yard with at least three modules for staging. He has not made his plans for this, yet. Several members are converting, or planning, to change from HO to an NTAK module.

I have partially ordered the Digitrax electronics for a new command station panel from The Whistle Stop. They are having trouble finding a distributor who has stock at the right price. We hope to have this ready for the next Dalton show in November. It will be mounted on the backside of the modules instead of underneath, where it is difficult to troubleshoot. We are using 2 American Flyer 250 watt, 16 amp, transformers for power.

The Division portion of the 50-50 raffle is placed in the module fund. Let's try to be generous and spend \$5.00 for six tickets instead of \$1.00 for one ticket. We also received \$175.00 for our display at the Dalton show. Your help in funding the Module Group is appreciated.
