
Superintendents Message

I went to my workshop the other day. I had ordered a scale from Mirco-Mark® and wanted to try it out. I had used an old postage scale but once the spring broke I didn't replace it until now.

I had just assembled a new flatcar. I had installed Jay-Bee wheels, Kadee couplers and adjusted the coupler height. (I use the heavier Jay-Bee wheels on flatcars to increase the weight and lower the center of gravity.) I expected to need to add some weight, which I did. NMRA RP-20.1 contains all of the information on the recommended car weights. For my HO forty-foot flatcar I need one ounce plus a half-ounce for every inch of car body length; in this case six inches. So, let's do some math. One plus (six divided by two) equals four ounces. Got that? I added the weight and the car was good to go.

Then since I had the scale out, let me test some older cars. What a surprise. Nearly all of them were too light! Oh boy, now I have a new project!

MODULE REPORT

Bob Ashley, Jr. has recovered enough to help on the modules. In fact, he went back to work doing light duty, but, will be having more surgeries in the coming weeks. Jim Hogue worked a full day with Bob and me and we accomplished quite a lot.

All the wiring is in place and ready for hookup to the track, when laid. We moved all the modules to Bob, Jr.'s garage and they are all assembled and free standing with legs.

I have taken on a design consulting job which will tie me up for the next three weeks during the day. Bob and I will be working on the modules on random evenings as our schedules permit. We hope we will be able to work on them on Saturdays during the day. If you can help, let us know which evenings or days you can be available. We are still planning, at this time, to have the modules ready for his March meeting. Because of the upcoming surgeries, this could change.

We have all the track, turnouts and roadbed to complete the main lines. I expect we will need additional money or donations to complete the yards and electrical for the layout. After that, we can start laying roadbed, track and wiring.

Everyone has paid me for the modules we had built previously. "Thank you" for clearing up that problem. I have had several requests for kits or finished standard modules. I will be ordering limited supplies and you must pay for your module prior to taking it with you. The price is \$67.00 each for the materials and \$33.00 each for the wiring kit. This does not include the mandatory NCE UTP Fascia Panel Socket for plugging in your throttle which is available for \$17.00 from me or at The Whistle Stop. This works with Digitrax or NCE. A module can be built without a UTP. These prices are subject to change, as I must order more materials and wiring supplies and the cost may change.

After I finish the design consulting job, anyone who wants to pay in advance and is willing to come to my house to construct the module please call me. I will be willing to help build their module(s). We are also looking

for new module members. Please call me for information.

Division 4 is setting up their modules at the Lodi Station Outlet Mall, 9911 Avon Lake Road, in Burbank Ohio this weekend, February 12 & 13 from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm. Please take the time to go see what can be accomplished. Take your spouse and family and visit the mall, also.

I want to thank the Division for investing in the module program. If we have the same success that Divisions 4 and 5 have had, this will provide a lot of entertainment for the members and the communities. It will also provide a way for each member to earn the AP awards.
