N-SCALE REPORT

At the September event a section of ¾ inch curved plywood roadbed, (below) was presented. The roadbed was assembled using a biscuit cutter and wood biscuits

as an alternative to metal connectors used in July NMRA.ORG article on building a helix. The biscuits provide strong joints which do not require the addition of nuts and bolts and the additional work needed to insure clearance between helix levels. In addition, if a compound cutoff saw is available it is possible to cut ends of a set of joints to produce a 1% rise at the entrance and 1% decline



at exit of the helix. Side supports based on threaded rod as shown in ORG article should work well with a roadbed made with biscuits. Overall the prefabricated biscuit roadbed could speed construction of your layout. See biscuit joiner and biscuits (left) and for infor-

mation on Biscuit Joinery on internet, search for "Biscuit Joinery Basics" and pick one of the tutorials.

An HO Borden's Butterdish Milk Tank Car was also featured in the July ORG. This was an interesting design and a search for an N-Scale model was undertaken. "KenRay Models" was found to have both kits and completed model available with 4 different road numbers as shown below. With two butterdish cars and two box cars industrial switching moving milk from farm to large city bottling plants could be implemented. Local freight box car would pickup milk cans at track side farm platforms and milk then delivered to regional creameries. Butterdish




