This month we will be at Bob Ashley Jr's in Akron, OH. See you there.




Convention 2014 Layout Committee Report



Don Bonk had teething problems with the NTRAK modules, due to a crossed wire in a new connector, but, he found the problem and was able to operate the layout. Thank you to those who came to help us because we were short handed.

We will setup and operate the Division HO modules and two or three straight modules in January at the regular division meeting at Bob Ashley, Jr.'s home in his big garage. The setup will be announced by email, if help is needed. The modules will remain assembled for a few weeks so we can make repairs to the curved turnouts on the right end and install several Tortoise switch machines. The March 23, 2014 showing of the modules, at Dalton, conflicts with the regular Sunday meeting. The meeting date is expected to be changed, because, we either miss the meeting or cancel the show and loose \$100.00, or more. (The meeting date has been changed to March 30. Ed.)

I am concerned that several module members have lost interest or cannot make the events. We need more members to join in with more modules. I am going to add one or two more modules to my coal mine and concrete/cement scenes. Those of you who have modules that you cannot use, please offer to sell them to someone who wants to join us. We are also considering making a yard with at least three modules for staging.

We expect to start purchasing the electronics for a new command station panel. We hope to have this ready for the next Dalton show. The panel will be mounted on the backside of the modules where it will be easier to troubleshoot.

The "Module Group" logo is available through Jim Williams or Nils Sunberg for \$6.00 and can be added to your shirts. Please have this done before the upcoming displays. Thanks to all who have already done this.

We also receive \$100.00, or more, for our display at the Dalton shows. Your help in funding the Module Group is appreciated. We hope to buy a DCC system with this money to replace my personal DCC system, soon.


