Did you note another NMRA dues increase stating January 1, 2020 was approved by the BOD at the Salt City Convention? This seems to becoming an annual event.



Leveling Modules has been one onerous task during set up. Getting down on the floor with a wrench to adjust module height becomes more difficult every year. In the Sept/Oct NTRAK Newsletter, Norm Dotti suggested using "U-Bracket Levelers" shown here which can be adjusted from above with a powered or unpowered screw driver. A set of these levelers was obtained from Amazon and they work as advertised. A cordless Dremel tool with a long screw driver head works well. But, there is a problem with the width at the mounting holes. Holes are near the edges of our module leg and screws could break out at installation or with heavy use. Quarter inch thick wood reinforcing plates the length of the channel should added (glued) to the bottom of the legs adjacent "U" channel mounting holes.




